Suggested retailer: jerrysartarama.com

1. Something to make marks on paper: markers, crayons, pens, brush pens, highlighters, Posca pens, Sharpie – in a variety of colors (at least 3 or 4 colors). Optional: Any kind of paint, could be just yellow, red, and blue, or other watercolors that you prefer. School-grade watercolors, like Prang, are fine.

2. Any drawing paper that you already have on hand, such as multimedia paper, or similar. If you don't have any on hand, this spiral-bound pad is good:

3. Simple collage materials: glue stick or tape, a variety of random magazine pages/newspapers with pictures and words (columns of text – we need a lot of words).
