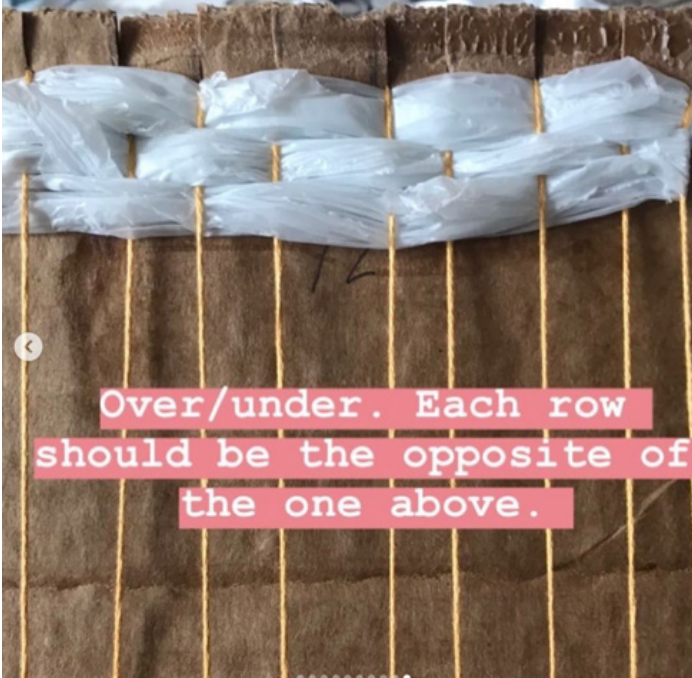

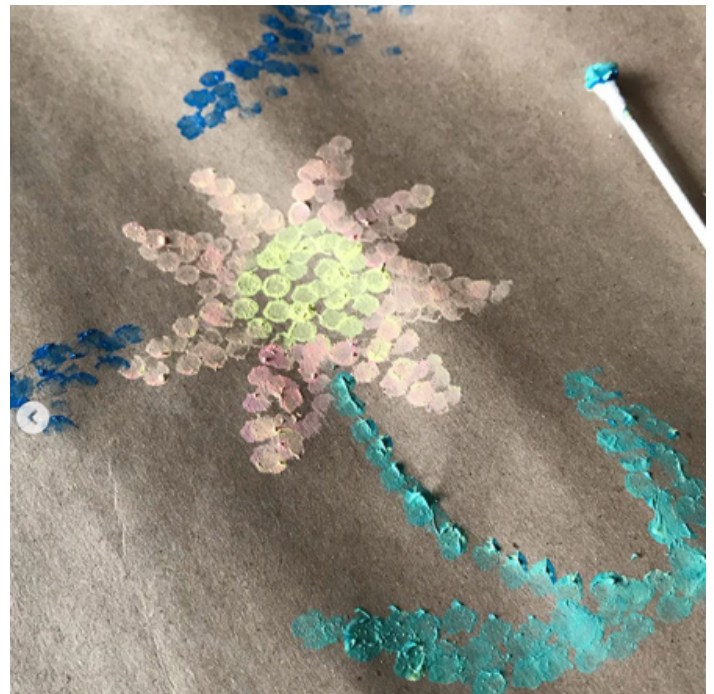


# ACTIVITY #3

Paint using dots! Use GEORGES SEURAT for inspiration.

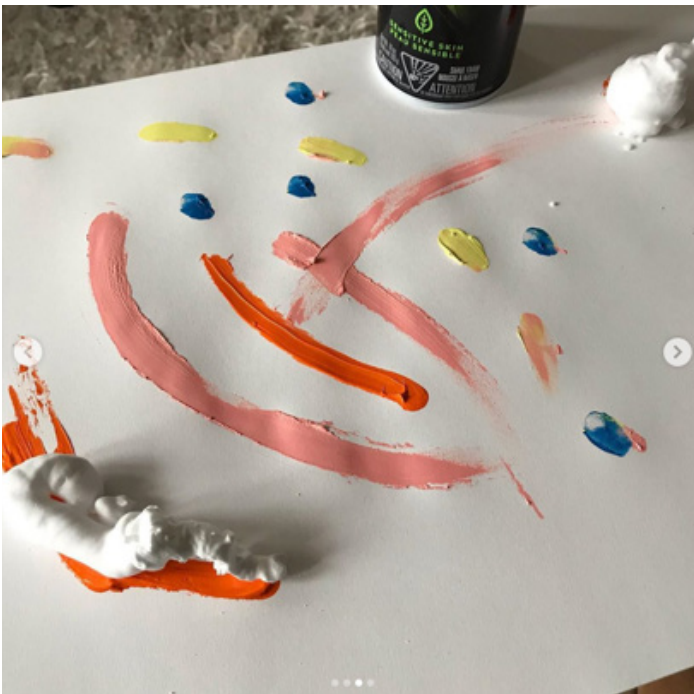




# ACTIVITY #4

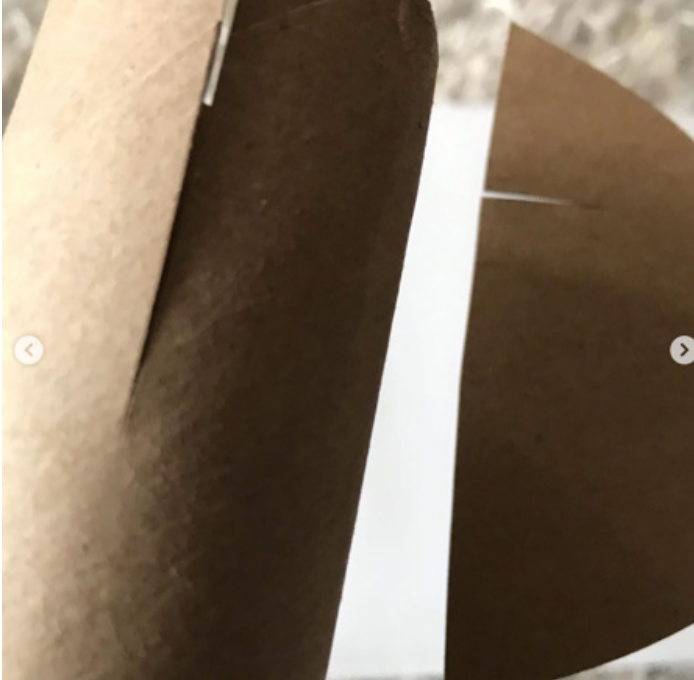

Foil is awesome for embossing, coloring, collaging and building sculptures.

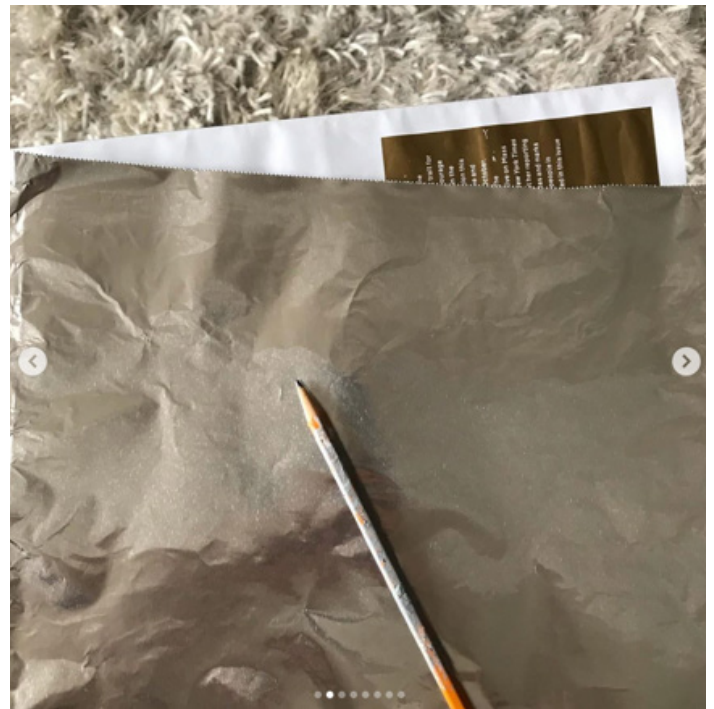
If you emboss - put newspaper or a magazine underneath 2 layers of foil for cushion and use a dull pencil for drawing carefully.

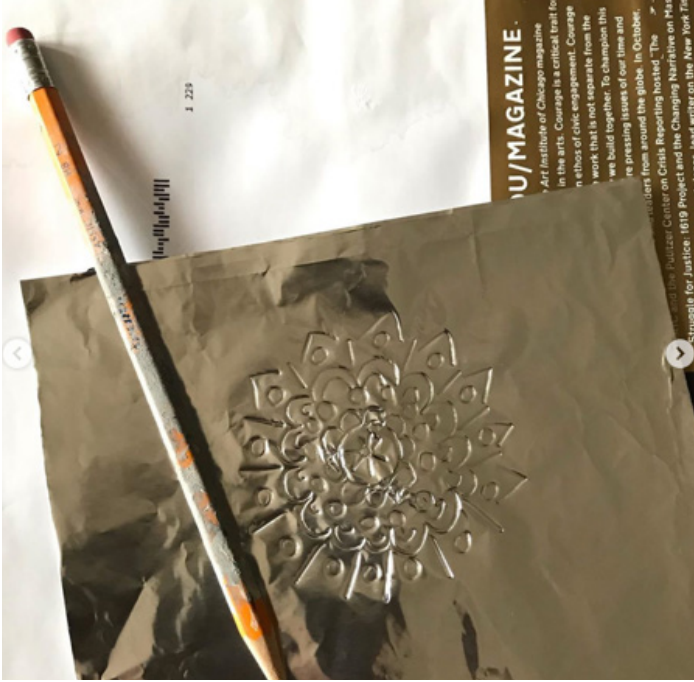
